This report, as required by R.S. 42:344(A), contains information concerning <u>St.</u> <u>Bernard Parish Library</u>'s compliance with the provisions of the Prevention of Sexual Harassment Law, R.S. 42:341, et seq, for the calendar year <u>2022</u>.

- <u>St. Bernard Parish Library</u> had <u>15</u> public servants complete the mandatory education and training on the prevention of sexual harassment as required by R.S. 42:343(A). This constitutes <u>100</u>% participation of the public servants of <u>St.</u> <u>Bernard Parish Library</u>.
- St. Bernard Parish Library received <u>0</u> complaints of alleged sexual harassment for the calendar year <u>2022</u>.
- 3. Of these complaints and upon completion of an investigation, <u>0</u> resulted in a finding that sexual harassment actually occurred.
- 4. Of these complaints which resulted in a finding that sexual harassment occurred, <u>0</u> resulted in disciplinary or corrective action being taken.
- 5. The amount of time required to resolve these complaints were as follows:

Complaint 1: <u>0 hours / 0 days</u> Complaint 2: <u>0 hours / 0 days</u>

The average time required to resolve all complaints totaled <u>0 hours/ 0 days</u>.
