To follow up on our phone conversation. The blue glass that was chosen for the job is not available from the manufacture for the foreseeable future. Gibbs has provided two samples that were in the job, both have blue glass on one side but one is frosted on one side. Please compare the alternate blue glass to both samples that were in the job.

The frosted glass has always been in the job and was sent to you because one of the sides does have the blue glass as part of its assembly. The frosted glass serves as a visual barrier primarily where glass is installed above the ceiling. It is also installed at the windows in the restrooms and lactation room.
